Minutes from previous meeting

Matters arising

JT advised that there was no WBCCC interest in Sustrans' Carnforth-Glasson Dock ride which, on reflection, was for the best as it was oversubscribed by Sustrans members. JT advised that he would still like to see the ride in the future WBCCC calendar.

HH/AG confirmed that a mobile phone, charger and SIM card had been sourced and the number would appear on future promotional material.

DM confirmed that he would look into the Christmas meal booking at the Stonecross, Golborne.

Calendar of rides

PB advised that there still continued to be very little interest in club rides and he felt that the time and effort he has committed to update the website has not been worthwhile; members were still not attending rides. There then followed a lengthy discussion with members expressing their thoughts on how to take the club forward. With 22 members paying subscription, but with only a hardcore group of 6-8 people regularly attending rides, the question arose as to how to engage new members as the current members did not wish to attend, for whatever reasons previously discussed. DR reported to the group his findings from his recent consultation with Active Living participants as to what was stopping them from joining WBCCC, reasons including :-

- time of Sunday rides
- club rides of 25-30 miles were too far (15-20 miles max)
- some participants feel apprehensive about going along to a ride where they don't know anyone
- the £10 subscription fee
- no ALT bikes available to use as they didn't have their own cycle
- the logistics of getting bikes to meeting points outside the Borough

Several ideas were discussed and the group agreed to try to engage Active Living participants by doing a ride which does not specify distance and encouraging a high proportion of members/ALT volunteers to attend to give participants a friendly, familiar face to

see on the day. Date was set for Monday 13th October, 10am – 1pm, meeting at Robin Park Arena going to Burscough Wharf, all encouraged to bring picnic lunch. Dates for two more rides were set for Sunday 16th November, Preston Guild Wheel and Monday 8th December (destination TBA).

Action :- JT, PB, DM, LM, GM, EA and AC all agreed to attend Mon 13th Oct ride **Action** :- PB to put details of all rides to website

Action : all WBCCC members to promote event to their ALT rides, DR to promote to other ALT cycle groups not represented at WBCCC meetings, ALT walking groups, etc Action : AG to pull leaflet together to promote event, DR to circulate to all members

AG circulated wording and asked the group to feedback any changes ASAP. The group agreed on an image.
