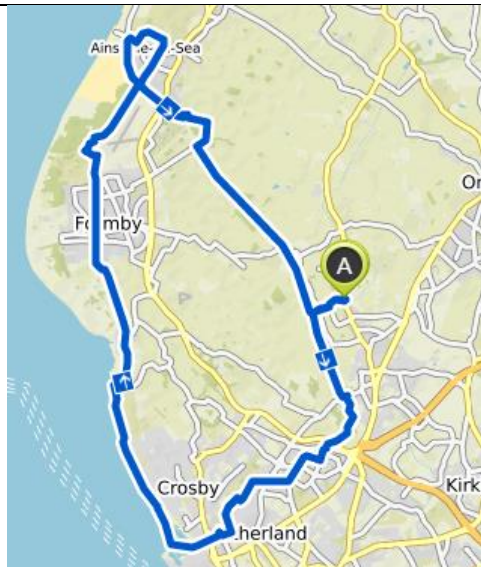

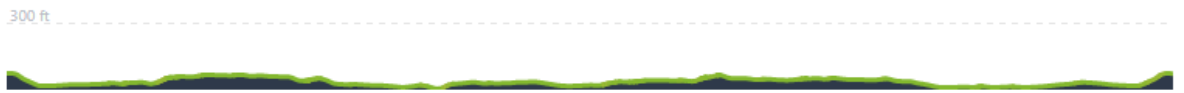
**Description** *This 29 miles ride is a good ride for someone wishing to test themselves over a slightly longer distance and is suitable for hybrid or mountain bike. It is an easy ride on relatively flat terrain with no hills and plenty of interesting sights on the route.*

*We leave Lydiate village, quickly join the Trans Pennine Trail and head out to Crosby passing along a picturesque section of the Leeds-Liverpool Canal, home to a variety of birdlife. We will have a brief comfort stop before cycling down the Crosby waterfront where we will stop to examine Another Place, a piece of modern sculpture by Sir Anthony Gormley that consists of 100 cast iron statues that face towards the sea. We then continue following coastal paths and trails through Blundellsands and Hightown. We cross the railway and Formby Golf course before entering the National Trust woodland occupied by red squirrels and pay a visit to the sand dunes overlooking the Irish Sea. We will take our refreshment break here so make sure to bring your lunch with you. We then follow the trail through the woodland and into Formby where we will join another section of the Trans Pennine Trail to complete the loop back to Lydiate.*

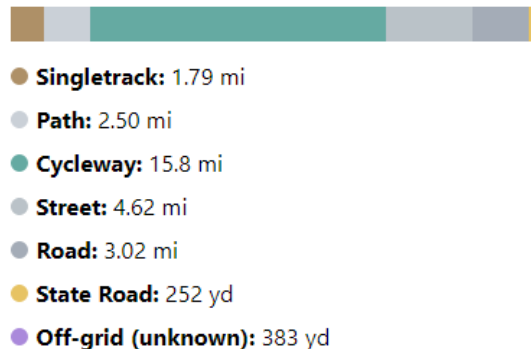
